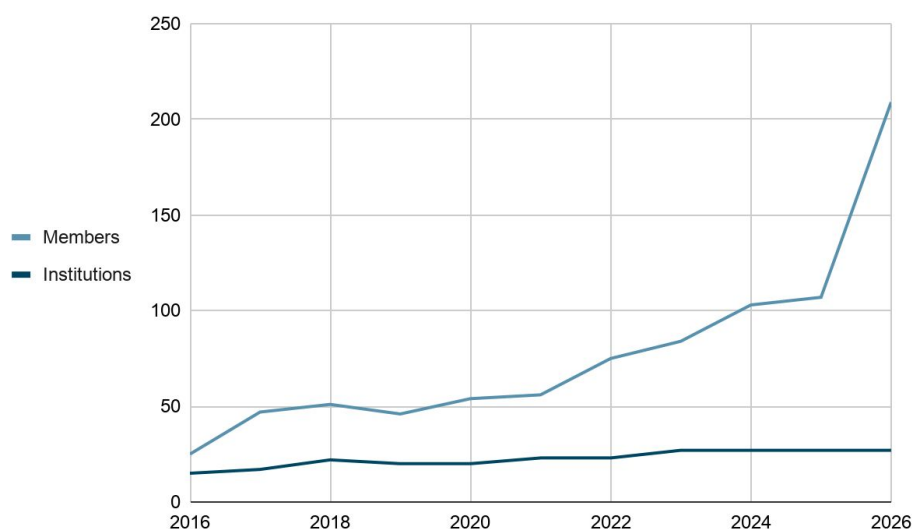

Through this year's Membership Campaign, the Florida Alliance more than doubled its membership!

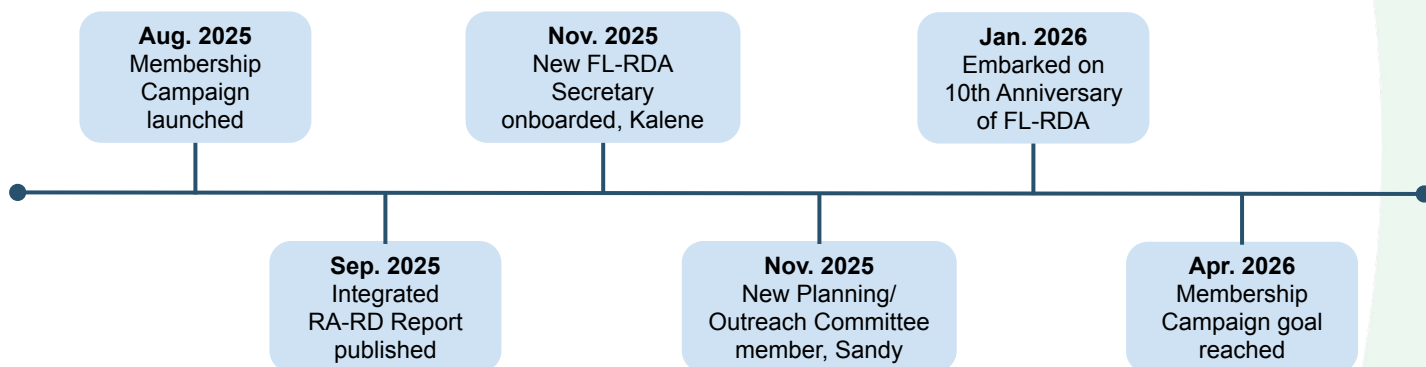

November 6-7, 2025 (and a Nov. 5 precon)
at University of Central Florida

At FL-RDA's 2025 annual conference at UCF we had not only two days of a main conference, but a full-day preconference focused on RA staff expanding their RD skillset. The main conference focused on "Navigating Research Development During Dynamic Times" and welcomed 82 attendees from 16 institutions across Florida.

Inter-Institutional Faculty Networking Event

*FAU's Division of Research
focuses on collaboration in
Alzheimer's research*

In March 2026, Alice Miehl, Steve Gregg, Sandy Siegman, and Alzheimer's Association leadership facilitated a networking event bringing together faculty from multiple Florida institutions working in the Alzheimer's disease research space. The event was attended by 70 faculty and staff (half in person and half virtually) from FAU, NSU, MPFI, FIU, USF, UF, and UF Scripps. It included opportunities for scholarly exchange and a presentation by the Alzheimer's Association on grant opportunities.



Integrated Research Administration Report

*A report compiling ideas and input
from RAs regarding expanding in RD*

Using NSF GRANTED funding, a team of FL-RDA members (Melanie Bauer, Rachel Goff-Albritton, Shari Moore, and Josh Roney) collected thoughts and experiences from RA professionals through surveys and focus groups. The focal topic was exploring ways that the RD knowledgebase could be accessed by a broader set of institutional stakeholders. RA professionals' interests in RD activities were assessed and recommendations made for how RA staff can be better supported to integrate proactive, capacity-building practices into their faculty support services. This report also inspired the 2025 FL-RDA preconference activities!

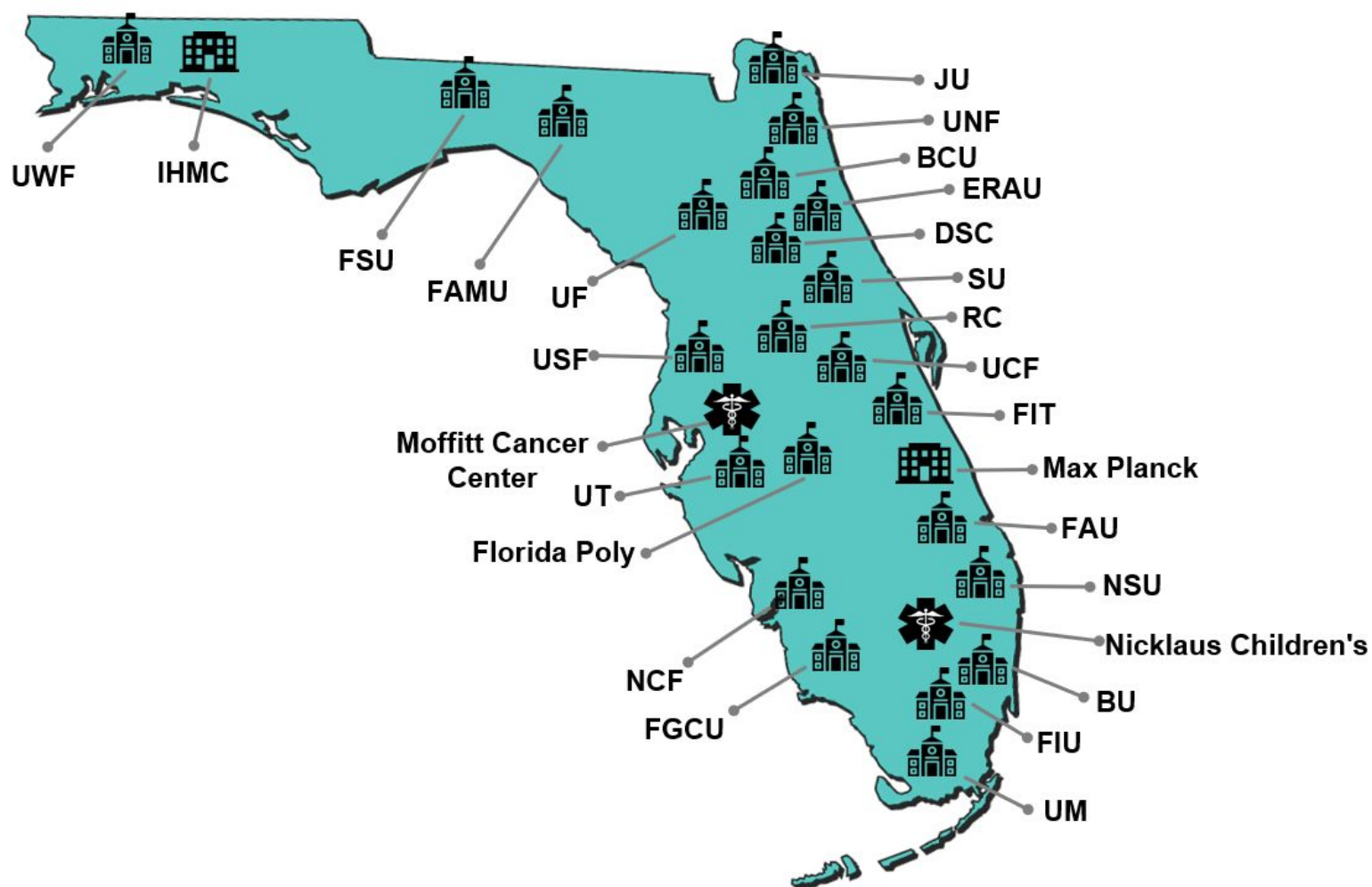
Regional Convening at UF
